## WHAT TO BRING

### From your Home:

- Aerosol cans
- Cleaners
- Spot removers
- Ammonia
- Computers
- Electronic equipment
- Hearing aid (button-style) batteries
- Nicad batteries
- Photo chemicals
- Chemistry sets
- Floor cleaners
- Oven cleaners
- Bleaches
- Compact Fluorescent Bulbs

### From your Yard:

- Insecticides
- Weed killers
- Pesticides/Herbicides
- Propane cylinders
- Swimming pool chemicals
- Wood preservatives
- Fertilizer
- Cesspool cleaners

### From your Work Bench:

- Adhesives
- Glues & Resins
- Hobby supplies
- Artist supplies
- Latex paint
- Oil paints
- Spray paint
- Stains
- Thinners & Stripper
- Sealers
- Solvents

### From your Garage:

- Car batteries
- Dry cell batteries
- Engine degreasers
- Brake fluids
- Transmission fluids
- Waste fuels (kerosene, gasoline)
- Antifreeze
- Engine and radiator fluids
- Radiator cleaner

## WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Ammunition
- Fireworks
- Explosives
- Infectious and Biological Waste
- Syringes
- Radioactive Waste
- Unknown Compressed Gas Cylinders

## TO ENSURE SAFETY

- **NEVER** Mix Chemicals
- **NEVER** Smoke while handling hazardous materials
- Do not place waste in plastic garbage bags
- Tighten all caps and lids
- Leave materials in original labeled containers
- Sort and pack paint, pesticides and household cleaners separately
- Pack containers in sturdy upright boxes and pad with newspaper

Also accepting e-waste (anything with a cord), tires, and used cooking grease at the Town Hall Parking Lot, old prescriptions at the Police Station entry door, and eyeglasses and cell phones at the Recreation Center.

Volunteers are always welcome to help with the Spring Litter Sweep at the Recreation Center. All supplies are provided.

This collection event is open to all residents of Spring Lake.
